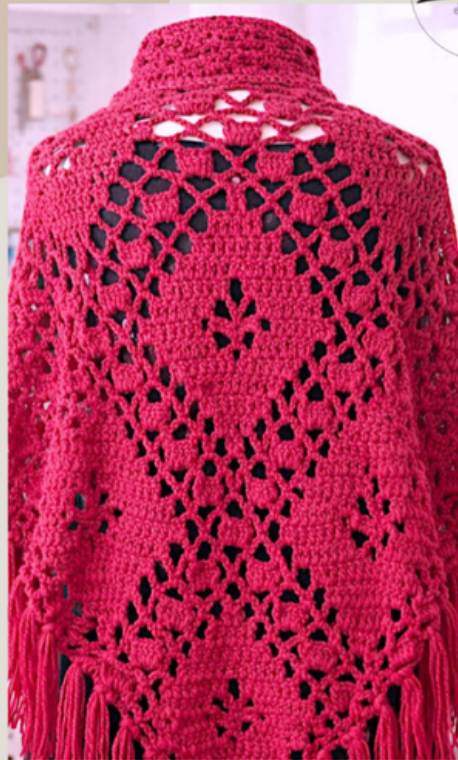

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Care of Your Crochet Shawl

To keep this handmade piece beautiful and in use for as long as possible, we recommend the following care:

- 
- Hand wash or machine wash in cold water, up to **30°C (86°F)**, using a mild detergent.
 - During and after washing, handle the shawl very gently. Press lightly by hand to remove excess water; if machine washing, use a low spin cycle.
 - After washing, lay the shawl flat and allow it to drain thoroughly, then leave it to dry in the shade.
 - It is best to iron the shawl while it is still slightly damp. Set the iron to a medium temperature and place a clean cotton cloth between the iron and the shawl.
